The subject matter of the course concerns the basic issues of public health in combination with elements of health economics and law. It includes interdisciplinary issues combining medical sciences, health sciences and social sciences to prevent disease, prolong life and promote the health of society. It presents public health problems in terms of individuals and communities, and takes into account national and international health challenges. It also concerns current health threats resulting from the globalization process and environmental contamination.

## Topics covered:

Social competencies

1. Definitions and theories of public health: review of the definition of PH, history and modern concept of public health. Public health as a scientific discipline and a field of practical activity.

- 2. The scope of public health issues. Issues of "Essential Public Health Functions". Health of the individual and community; health as an individual and social good.
- 3. Socio-environmental determinants of health. Diseases related to exposure to water, soil and air pollution.
- 4. Major health problems of the 21st century. Challenges and health threats of the globalization process.
- 5. The Public Health Act and the National Health Program goals, scope, basic tasks.
- 6. Health promotion and prevention implementation of health promotion programs and projects. Creation of the above-mentioned programs.
- 7. The importance of public health in the European Union, international health problems.
- 8. Fundamentals of economics and management in health care. Economics and health economics. Characteristics of health economics; health care market.
- 9. The role of economic analyzes and medical-economic compromise in making systemic decisions. Health care systems and sources of their financing.
- 10. Legal and medical issues in theory and practice legal grounds for practicing medical professions. Legal liability for practicing the profession: professional, civil, criminal. Professional self-government its importance in everyday practice.
